Proceeds from this tournament will help cover operating costs for the mission.




Boulware Mission Leadership Breakfast

Spring fever has definitely hit Boulware! The mission is bustling with activities involving clients, staff, and volunteers. Our grounds have recently received a face-lift thanks to several groups from our community and we've made many improvements to the building as well.

Our client census has been very high for several months. The staff have done an amazing job. There is never a simplistic answer to the problems of the poor!

Boulware's program strives to answer those problems through a holistic approach that deals with the spiritual, social, economic, political, cultural, emotional, physical, judicial, educational,

SERVICE OUTCOMES

Beginning in July of 2012, the staff at Boulware Mission began tracking certain outcomes to share with friends and supporters of the mission.

Following are some of the outcomes measured from the time period of July 1, 2012—April 15, 2013:

Admissions:

- 257 homeless clients were admitted
- 8% stayed less than 5 days
- 28% were former clients at one time
- 12 clients were veterans
- 18 clients were disabled
- 90% of clients had drug/alcohol addictions

Education

- 46 clients did not have a high school diploma
- 82% of them attended GED tutoring
- 5 clients earned their GED
- 5 clients enrolled in college



Treatment

- 150 clients entered Boulware's licensed treatment program
- 90% completed the treatment program
- 93% demonstrated an increase in knowledge about drugs & alcohol
- 96% demonstrated a change in perception about drugs & alcohol


Financial Literacy

- 86% of clients attended financial literacy classes
- 100% demonstrated an increase in knowledge
- 80% of clients demonstrated good financial practices through use of a budget, savings, and paying toward debt

Employment

- 85% of those able to work found gainful employment while at the mission

YOUR IMPACT IN STAN'S LIFE



In an effort to spotlight client success, we would like to share Stan's story with our readers.

Stan came to Boulware after being released from prison in the summer of 2012. He had no money, no job, no place to live, and no hope for the future. He had been addicted to alcohol for many years.

Boulware Mission provided a safe, supportive environment to Stan while he worked on changing his life. Stan attended financial literacy class and learned

budgeting skills and good financial management practices. He also worked on his coping skills, decision making, and relationships; and learned about nutrition and healthy living.

By attending alcohol education classes and 12-step meetings, Stan learned how to live a sober life.

Stan says that it was at Boulware that his sobriety became something that he wanted and not just something he had to do because of his legal issues...Boulware gave his sobriety value to him.

Stan worked hard and before long he became a role model for other clients.

Today, as a senior client, he serves in a leadership role at the mission. He still resides at Boulware, but has been given a

security position on weekends. Stan was recently approved for SSI disability benefits and has worked very hard to save money and pay off his debts. He said that for the first time in his life he feels like he has financial security.

Stan's future plans include moving out of the mission into a place of his own. In the meantime, he is working hard on self-improvement and looks forward to returning to life as an independent, productive citizen.

It is thanks to each of our supporter's that Stan's life has changed so drastically. He is eternally thankful for your impact in his life!
